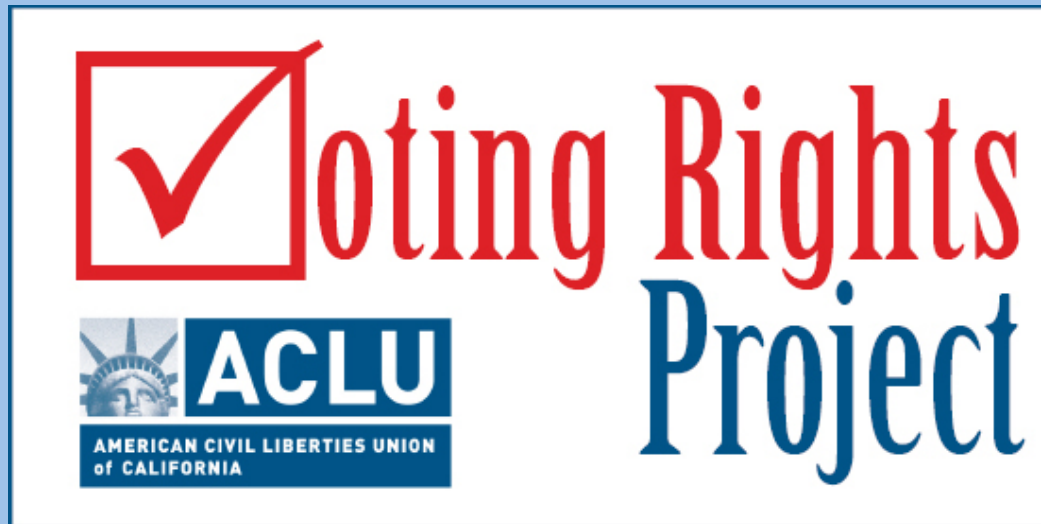

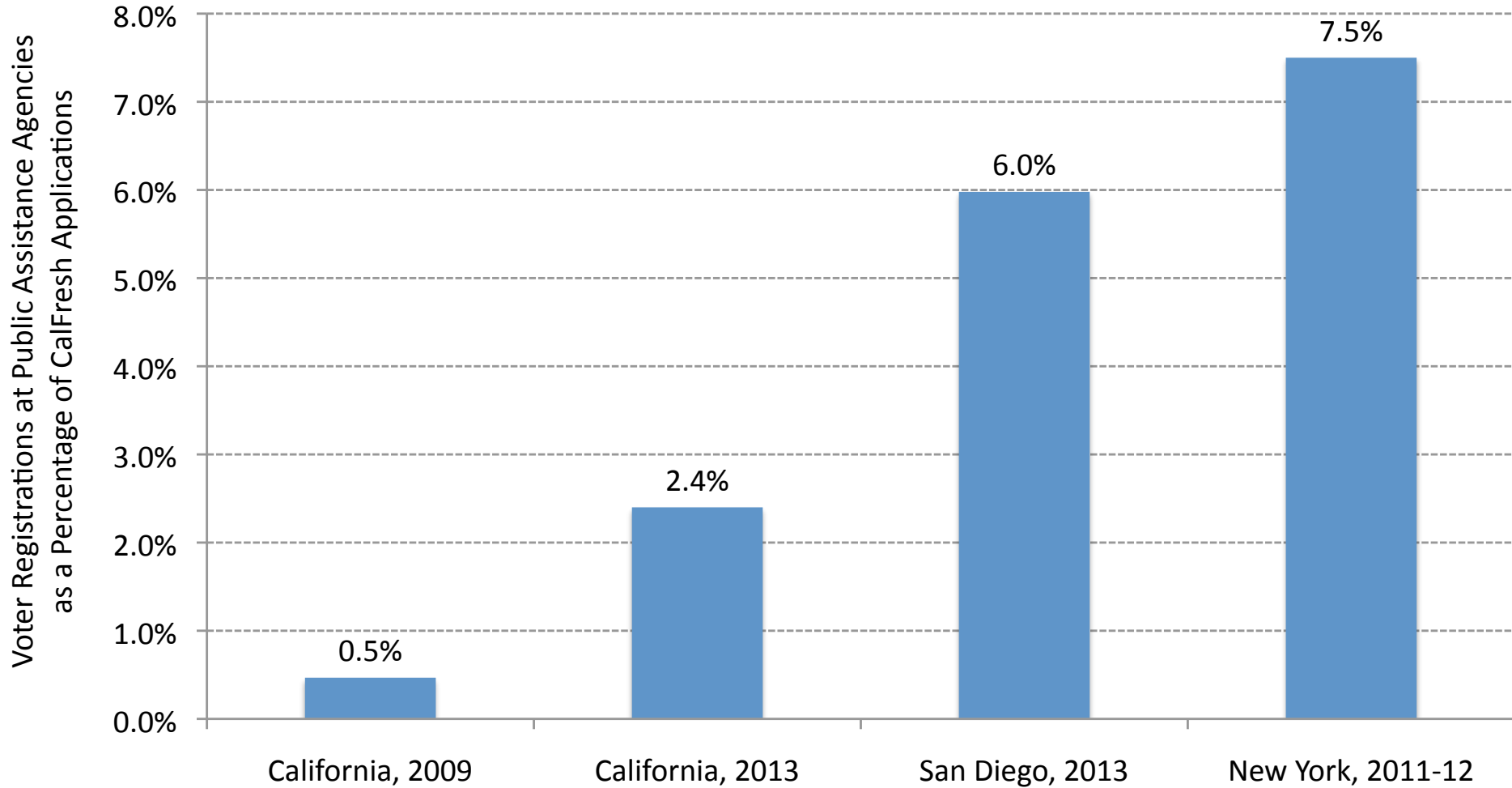
ACLU NVRA Implementation Project

- Pilot project began in 2011 in San Diego County
- Best practices from San Diego included in SB 35
 - Best practices
 - Accountability
 - Modernization
- Working collaboratively with:
 - Secretary of State's office
 - County elections offices
 - State and local NVRA agencies
 - Advocacy organizations
 - Professional associations

Voter Registration at Public Assistance Offices Have Improved Dramatically

- Registrations were up 472% at public assistance agencies from 2009 to 2013.
- Registrations improved from 2009 to 2013 in 50 counties.
- Registrations are up from 2009 to 2013:
 - 3,262% in San Diego County
 - 1,476% in Riverside County.
 - 524% in San Bernardino County
 - 255% in Orange County
