




Different Levels of Outreach/ Education Campaign

-To public assistance agencies: collaboration with ACLU and SOS

Rights to Register and Vote

Common misconceptions:

- If the person has a disability: physical, psychiatric, intellectual, developmental disability, etc.
- If the person is not able to read or write
- if the person uses a wheelchair
- If the person is under a conservatorship

Rights to Register and Vote

Parent, Conservator, Social Worker, Case Manager, Service Coordinator, Service Provider, etc. do <u>not</u> have the right to decide whether a person with a disability has the right to register and vote.
