2020 Presidential Primary Election - Get Ready to Vote

In 2020, Los Angeles County voters have more days and more locations to vote. Whether by mail or in-person, voting is more convenient than ever.

Party matters for the Presidential Primary Election.

- If you are not registered with a political party your ballot will not list the candidates for president, unless you request a partisan ballot. Learn more at www.sos.ca.gov/elections/voting-info/how-vote-president/
- Check your voter registration status: <u>lavote.net/vrstatus</u>

Vote By Mail - More options for returning your ballot. No stamps needed.

- Request a vote by mail ballot by February 25.
- Don't forget to sign and date your vote by mail return envelope.
- Return your ballot:
 - o By mail. No stamp needed. Must be postmarked by Election Day, March 3.
 - Drop off at a ballot drop box. Find a location at <u>lavote.net</u>
 - Drop off at any vote center starting Feb 22. Find a location at <u>lavote.net</u>
 - o Give to a trusted friend, family member or person to return for you.
- Voters with disabilities may request a remote accessible vote by mail ballot and use their own accessible technology to mark their ballot.
- Voters may request materials in any of the following 13 languages: English, Armenian, Chinese, Cambodian/Khmer, Farsi, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog/Filipino, Vietnamese, Hindi, Japanese, Thai, Russian

Vote In Person - Vote early. Vote anywhere in LA County. Every day is Election Day – February 22, 2020 to March 3, 2020.

- Vote early at any vote center in the county. Find a location at <u>lavote.net</u>
- Register and vote the same day.
- Use the Interactive Sample Ballot to make voting selections before you arrive.
- Vote with Los Angeles County's new fully accessible voting machine.
- Vote in any one of 13 languages.
- Print your ballot and cast your ballot without leaving your voting booth
