# Weaving BHC Sites for Statewide Collaboration

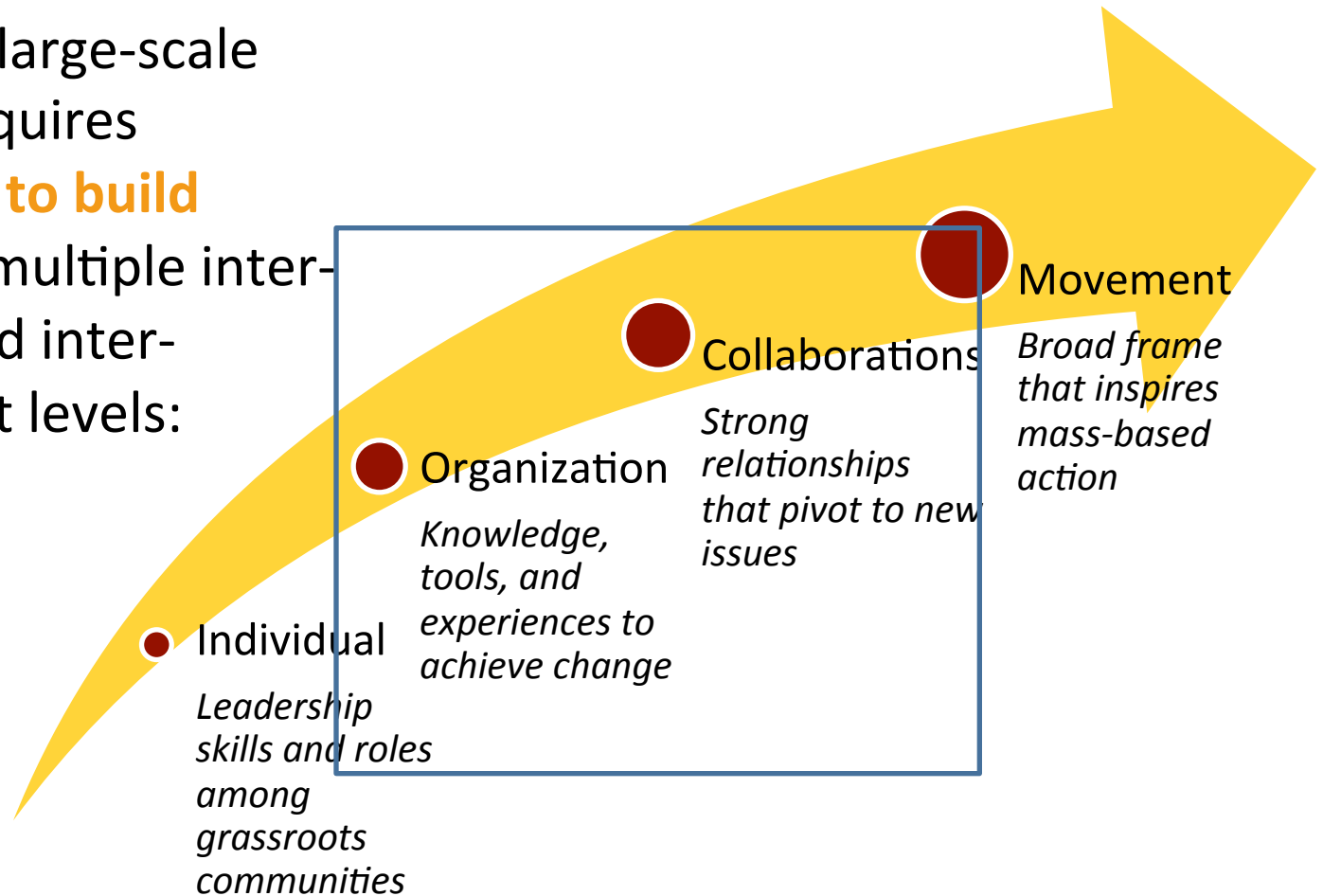
