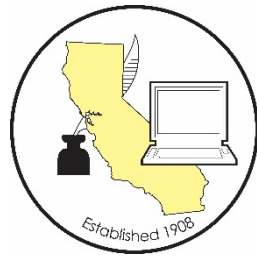

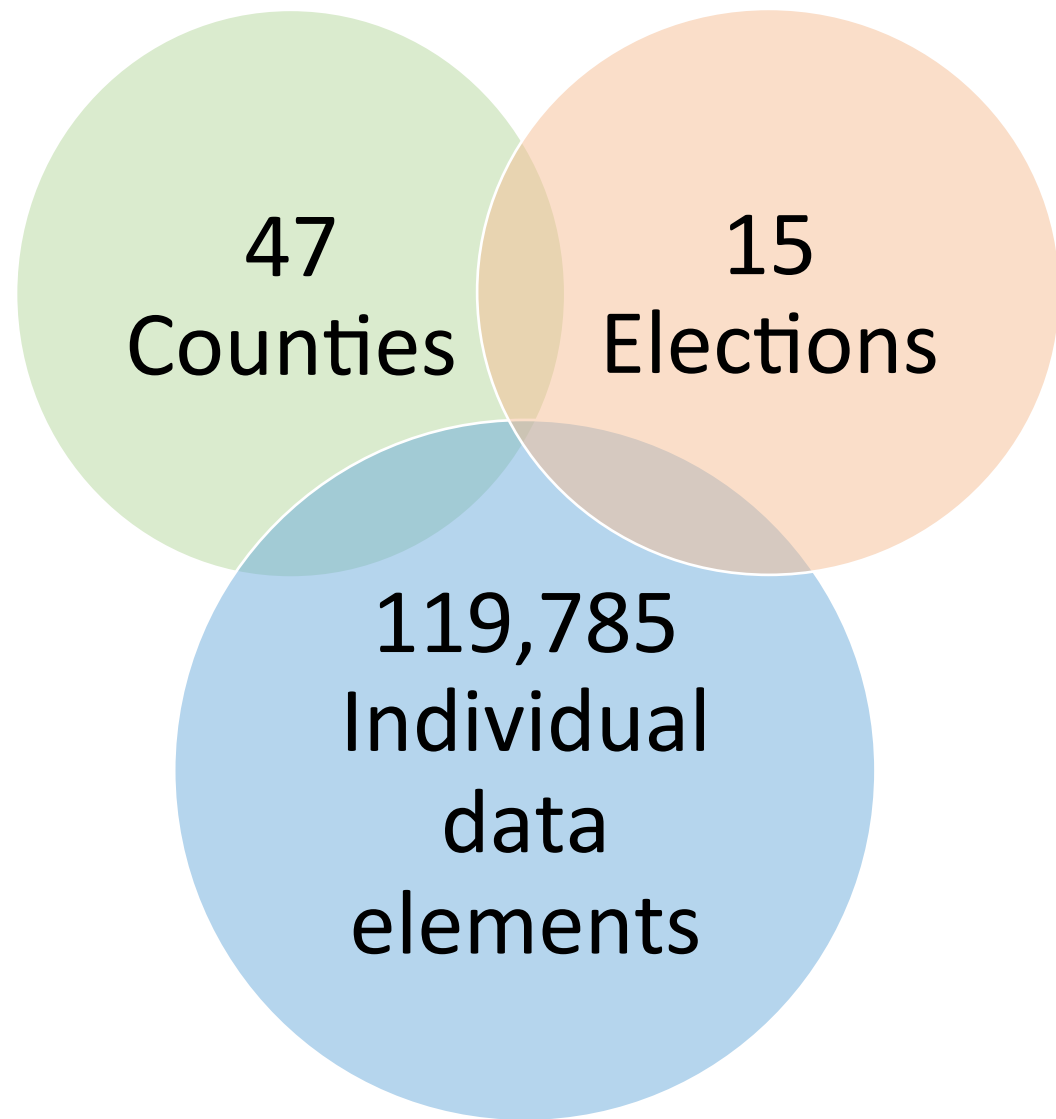
Grant funded to CACEO through FOCE by Irvine in 2013

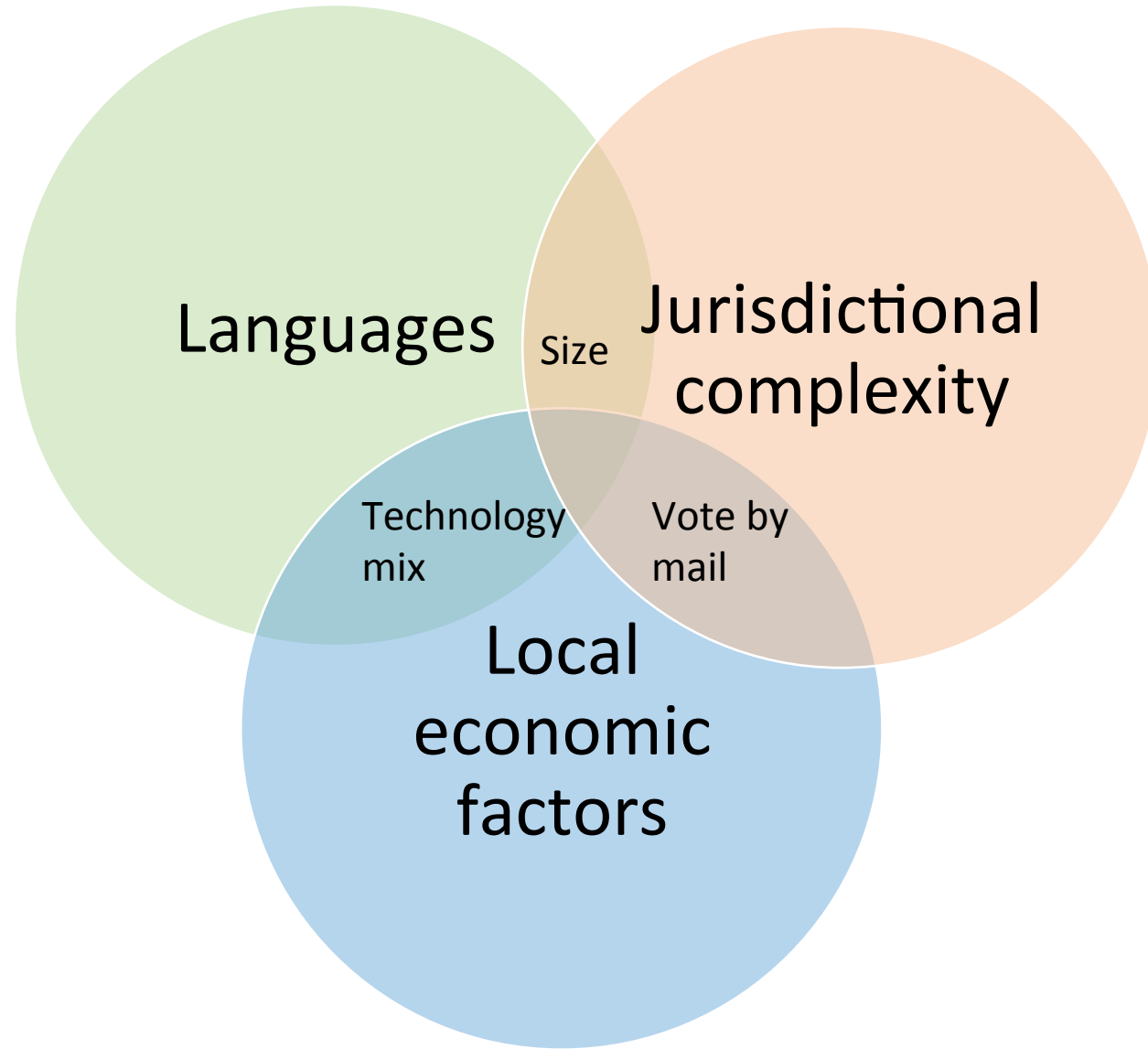
Contractor (Q2) selected, data survey tool developed, data collection began 2014

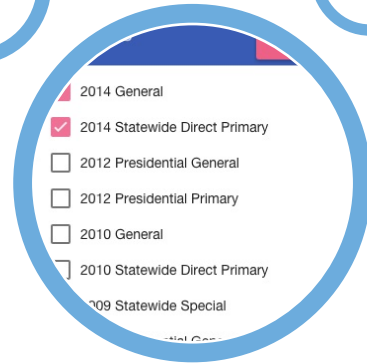
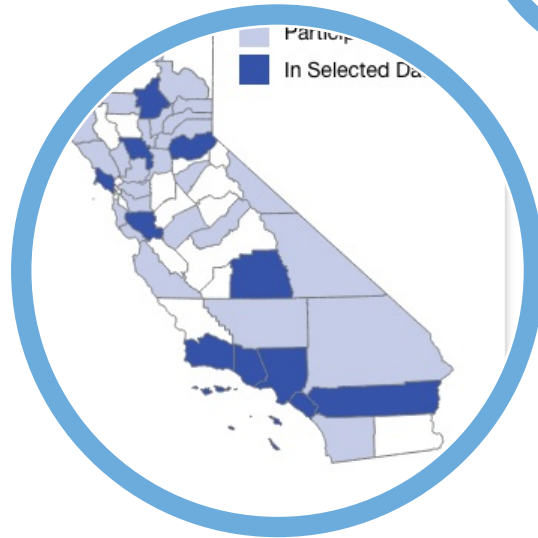
Ways to look at costs

- Per “vote opportunity”

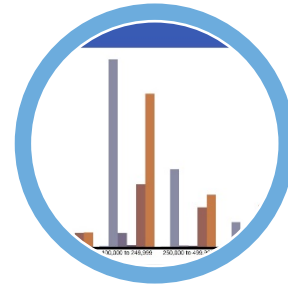

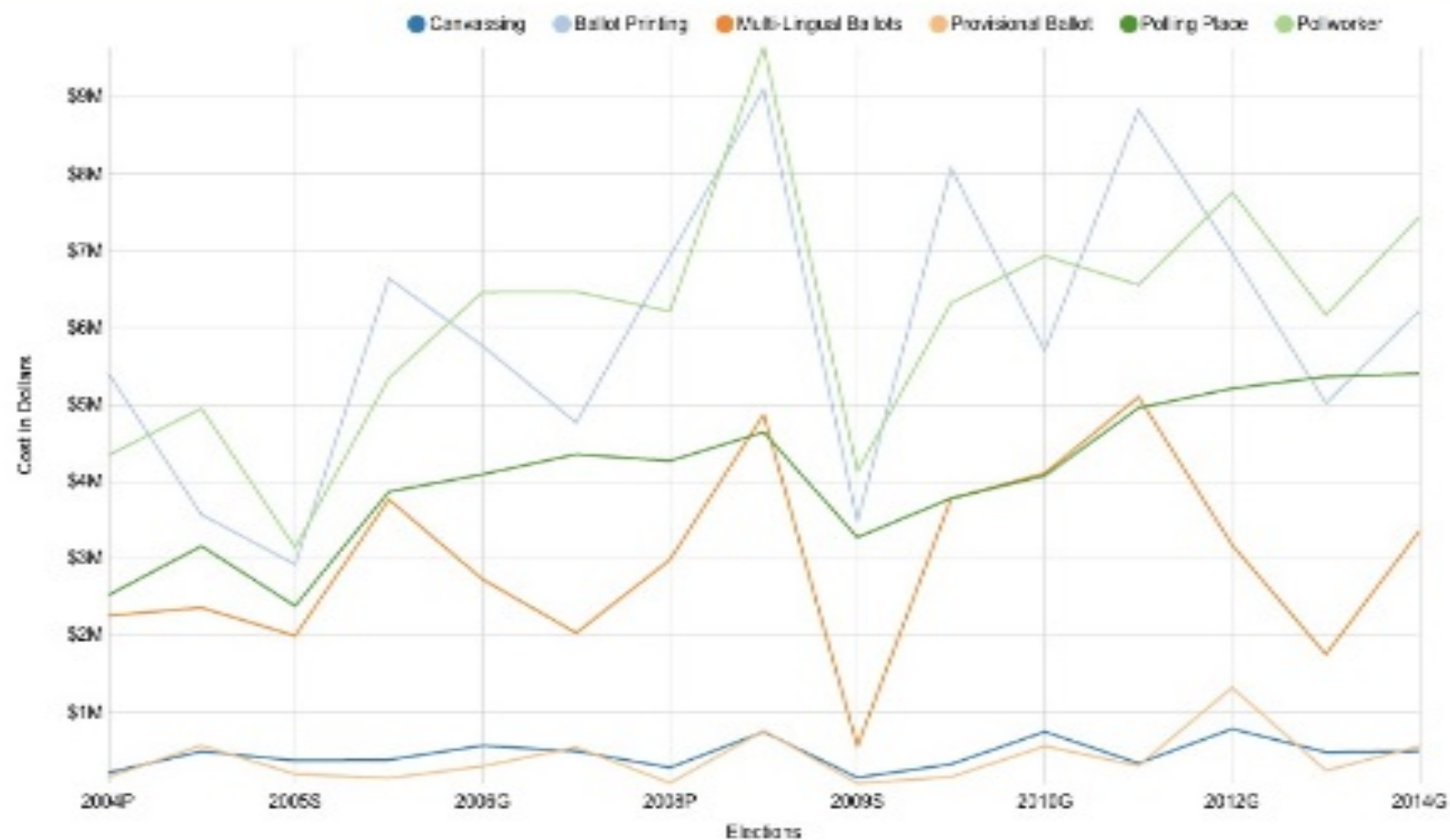

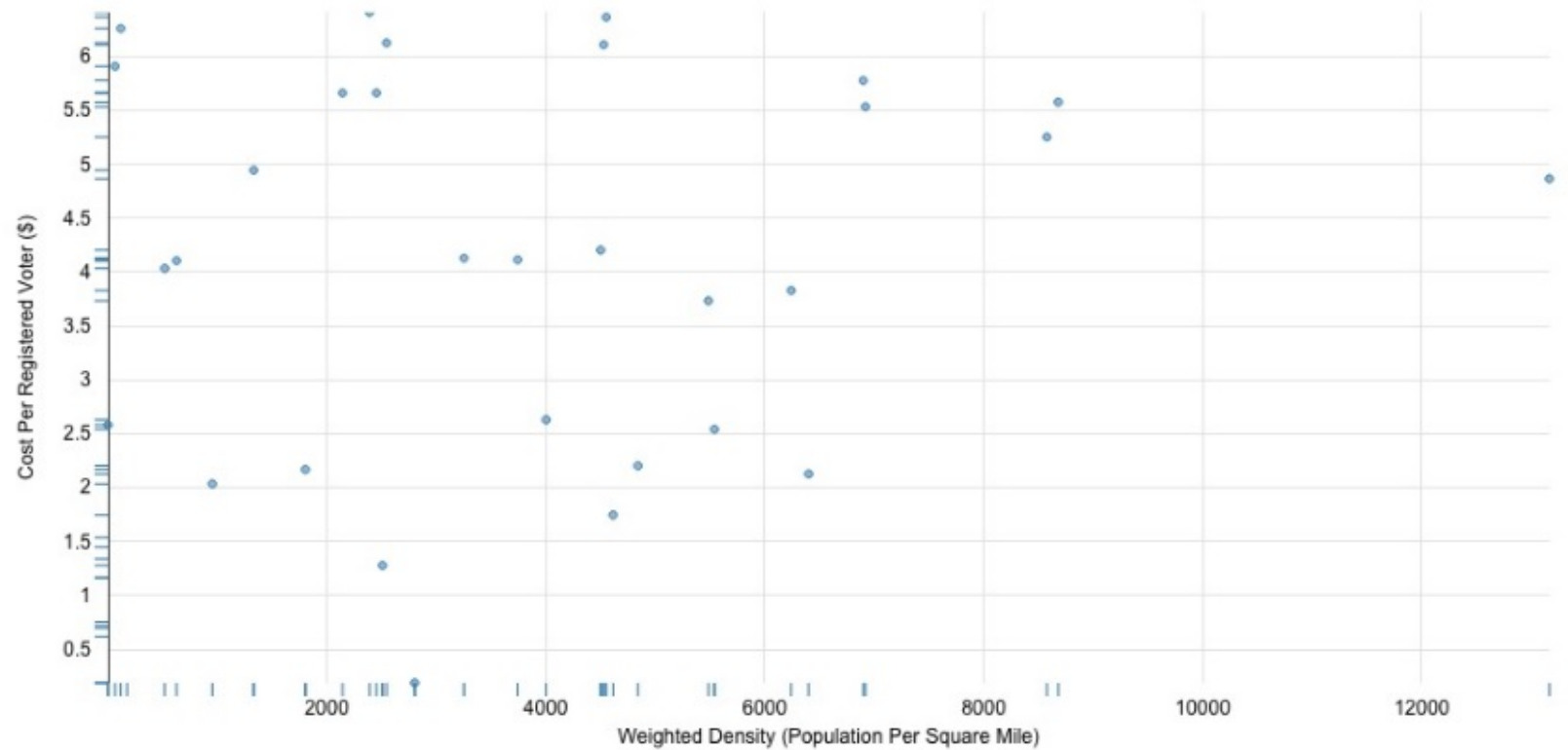

Election Costs and Population Density

This graph uses *weighted* population density to compare different counties. Weighted density measures the density at which the average citizen lives, taking into account how many people live in cities and towns even in very sparsely populated counties.

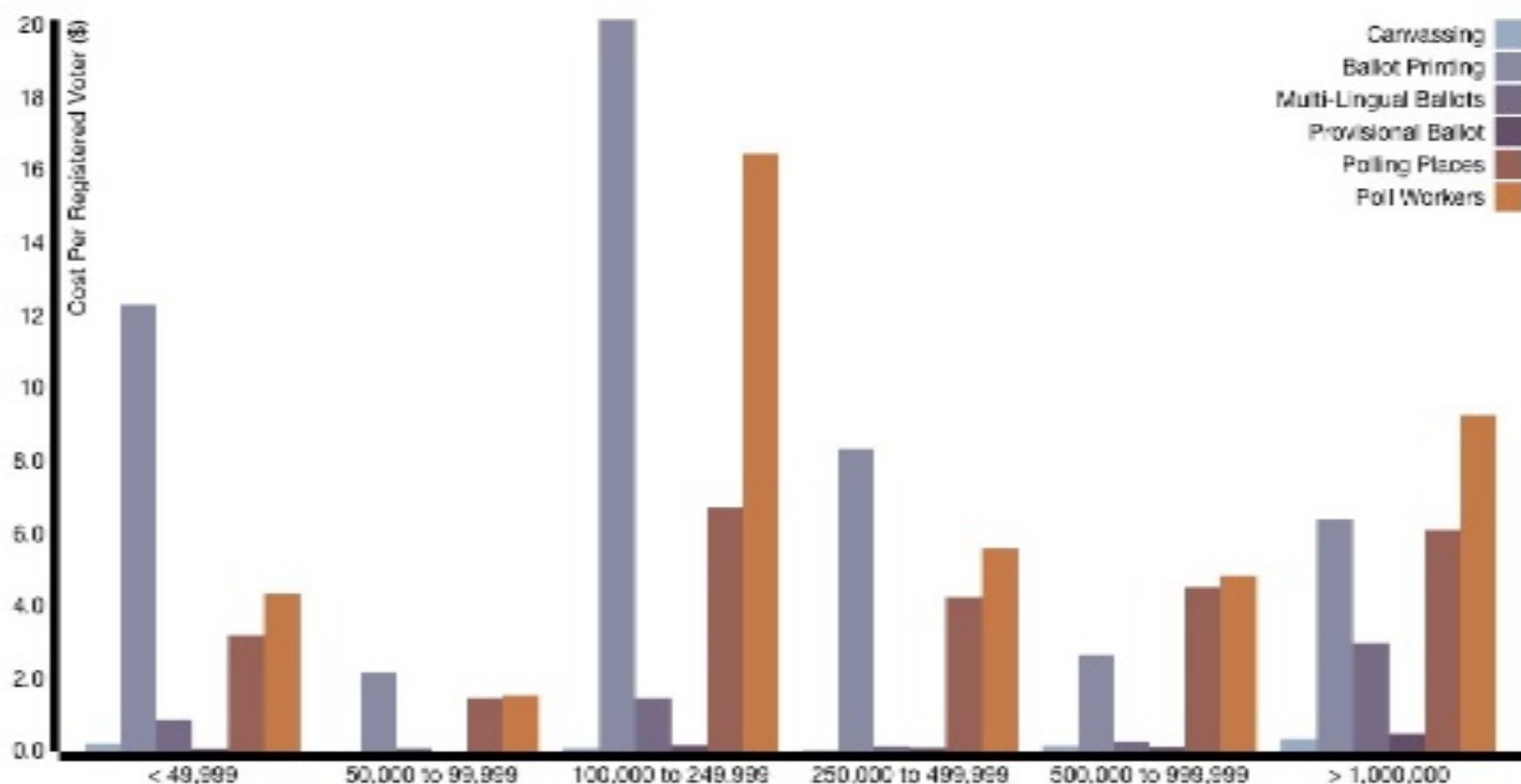
