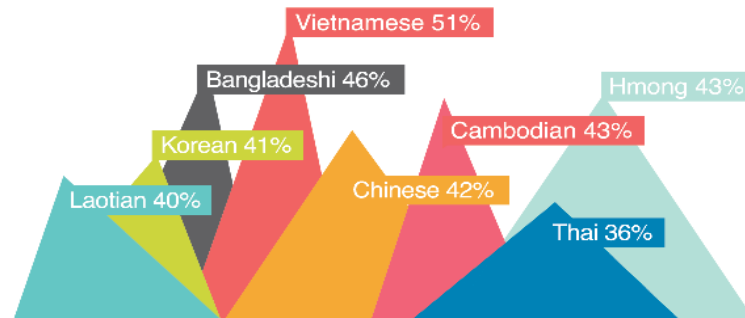

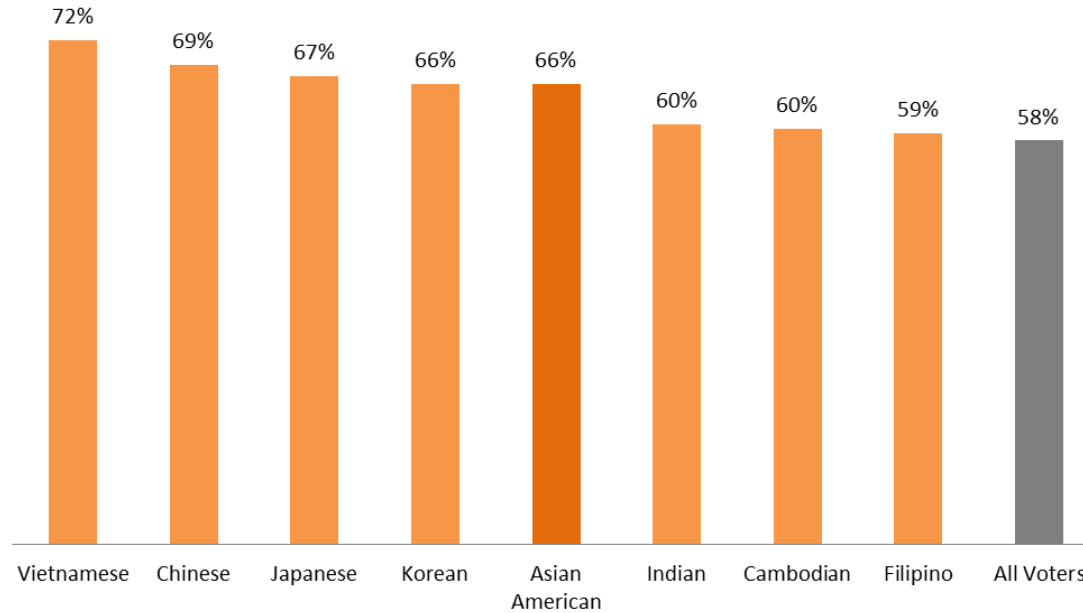

California, November 2016

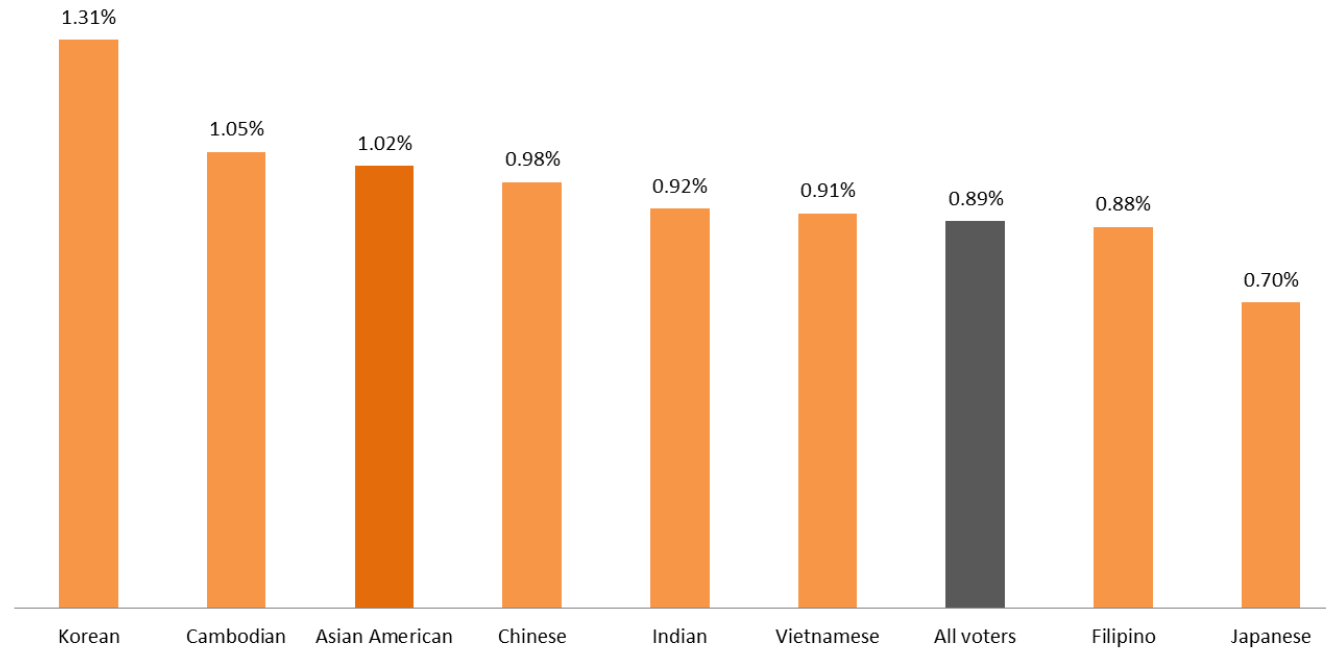

## VBM ballot rejection rates

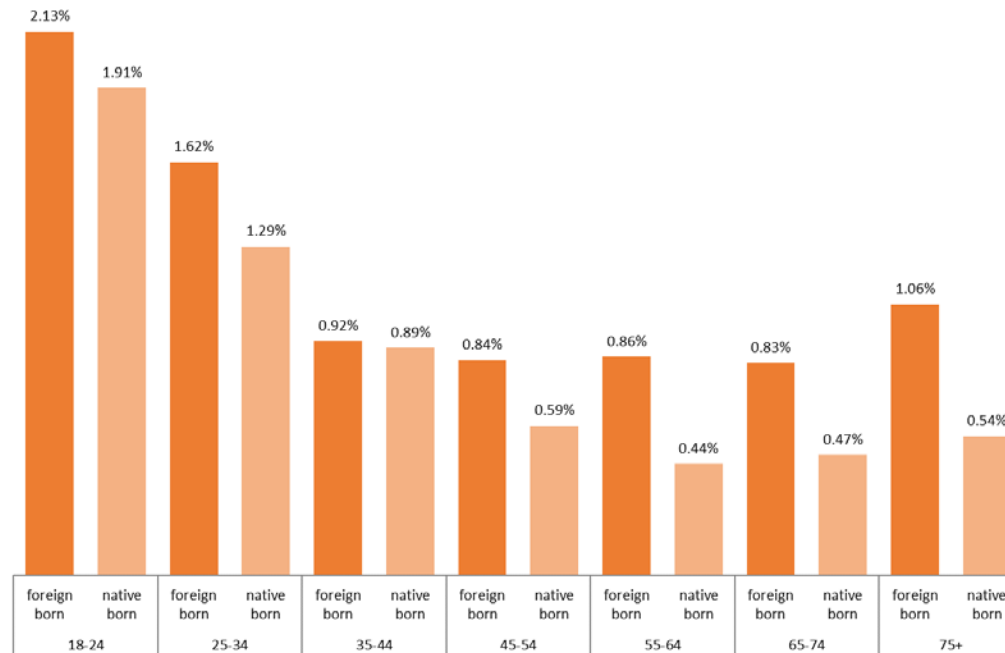
by race and ethnic group, November 2016

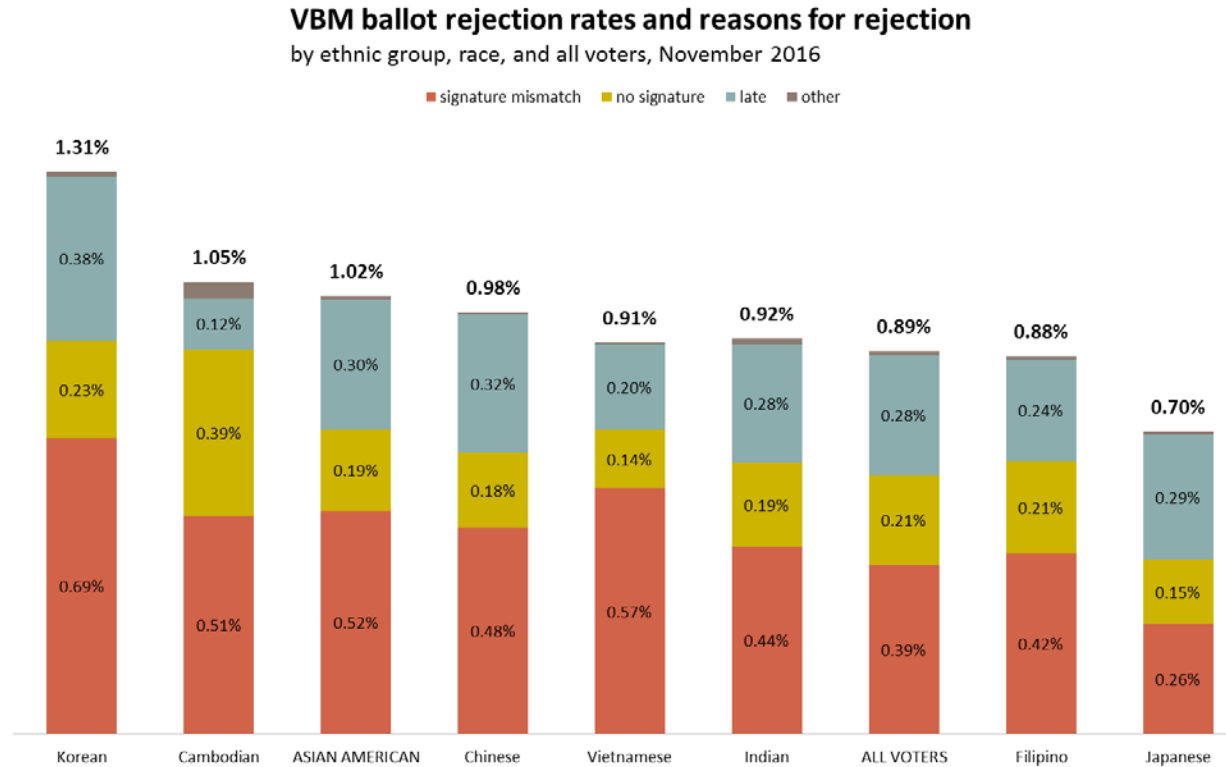

by age and nativity, November 2016



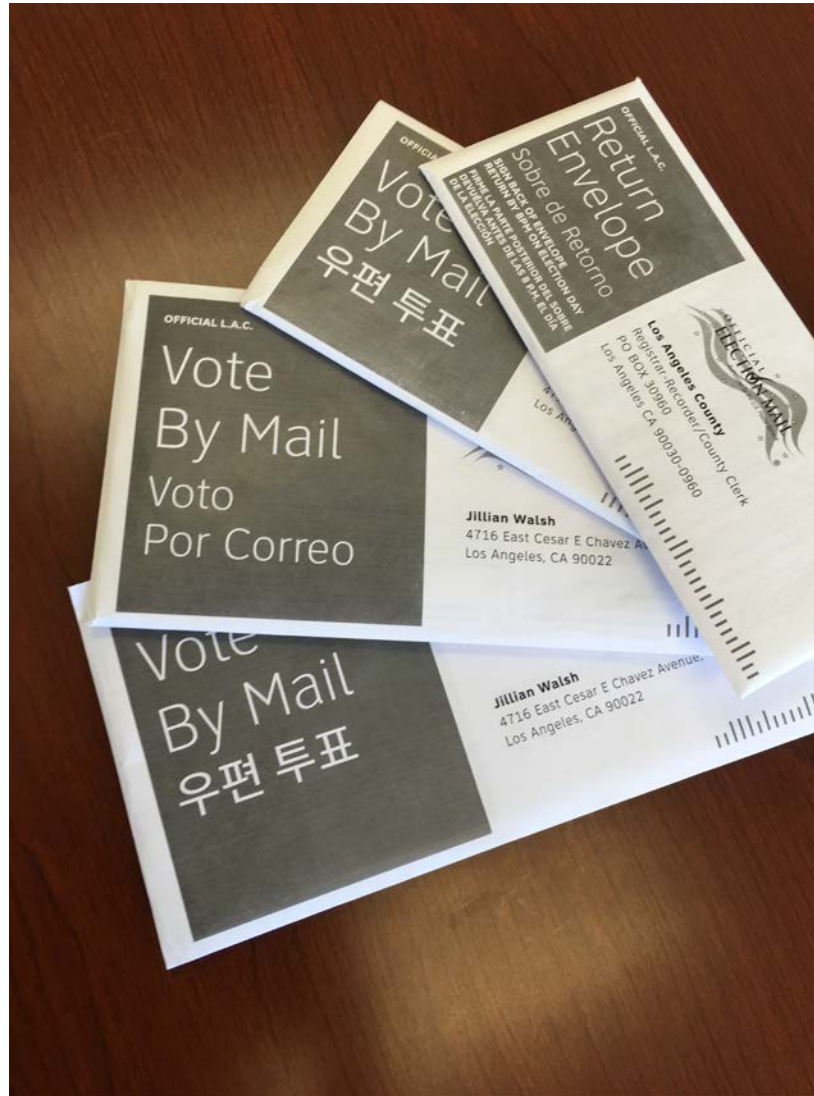
