VoteCal: Conditional Voter Registration

- Became effective January 1, 2017.
- Allows voters to register and vote in an election after the 15-day close of registration.
- Voters must come to the Election Office to complete the process.
- After processing the registration, Election officials determine if the voter has already cast a ballot in the election, and if not, issue a CVR ballot.
- 13 counties have conducted elections under CVR this year.

VoteCal: 16 year old pre-registration

- Similar to the process for 17 year old pre-registration.
- Registration becomes active on their 18th birthday.
- Notice is sent out to verify the registration information.

VoteCal: New Motor Voter Act (AB1461)

- Automated voter registration when obtaining or renewing a driver's license or changing address.
- Voter has to confirm the registration information and select choices (party, VBM, language, etc.)
- SOS to develop regulations to implement the program.
- DMV has to create an infrastructure to capture and submit the data to the SOS.
